Interested in DNS technologies?

SERI KEMBANGAN: MYNIC, the ".my" domain administrator will be conducting a series of training workshops on the domain name system's latest technologies next month.

Called the ".my Training Workshop Series 2007," it is aimed at increasing the knowledge pool on DNS.

It hopes to provide the academia, researchers, practitioners in information technology, as well as the general public with real-life, practical approaches on the newest technologies used to enable easy, fast accessibility and management of domain names.

The event will also be a platform to share ideas and knowledge on key technologies that will have an impact on how domain name systems will be managed, accessed and deployed in the near future.

Topics will include IPV6 (Internet Protocol version 6) which is hoped will overcome many of the serious limitations of the current Internet Protocol version 4; ENUM (telephone number mapping) technology, a DNS-based protocol to unify the telephone system with the Internet; and Voice-over-Internet Protocol technology that allows telephone calls to be made over computer networks.

The series of workshops will be held at the Palace of the Golden Horses Hotel from Aug 20 to 30.

Each workshop is limited to only 30 participants; registration will be on a first-come-first-served basis.
